HOW IT WORKS:

We adjusted our shipping policy and prices in January 2019. All orders over \$75 now ship for free, and smaller orders ship for a flat \$7.50 fee. You may notice that some case prices have gone up, but the change is minimal—you'll pay just a few pennies more per cup. This update allows us

“THE BEST WAY to honor the farmers who grow the coffee is to respect the fact that coffee is unique. Everywhere that it comes from has a slightly different profile, so you’re constantly making adjustments on the roaster to bring out the sweetness and character of each roast. But when you get into the flow of things and everything is going right, it’s one of the best things in the world.”

Coffee roasting is the science of taking raw, mostly flavorless and odorless coffee beans and transforming them through heat. The length of time spent roasting the beans determines how the coffee tastes when brewed. Our skilled employees use creativity and judgment to optimize the aroma and flavor of every distinct batch.

Equal Exchange’s worker-owned coffee roasting operation is the largest in the U.S., with two machines in use. We keep them firing five days a week, which ensures the freshness of the coffee we ship to you!

Roasting doesn’t really affect the amount of caffeine in a bean. But darker roasts lose more weight during roasting. That means a cup of dark roast usually has more buzz than a cup of light roast.



In the 1970s, Americans moved from gelatin molds and canned vegetables to raw ginger and bulk whole grains. Co-op grocery stores made these new foods accessible—and their democratic organization structure empowered consumers. In this episode, **Susan Sklar** takes us back to those days, and shows us how we've come full circle.



EPISODE 3: CONFLICT, COFFEE FARMERS AND THE NOBEL PEACE PRIZE

New Products from THE WEST BANK

The odds are against Palestinian farmers. Their parcels of land are small, and the Israeli West Bank barrier restricts movement and access to water. Though olive trees can produce fruit in very dry conditions, crops like wheat, almonds, and dates are affected by a climate that's becoming more arid and by the regulations of the Israeli government.

We've teamed up with PARC, the Palestinian Agricultural Development Association, to bring you traditional and delicious Middle Eastern products from small-scale farmers in the West Bank and Gaza. This fair trade partnership provides agricultural co-ops with important market access—and hope for the future.



Medjool dates come from the date palm, which can grow even when there's salt in the water—important for West Bank farmers whose access to fresh well water is limited.

The women of the **Machtas Cooperative** make decisions collectively and set their own work hours. Their maftoul is formed by hand in the traditional manner.



At PARC's agronomist training centers, young college graduates spend a year doing a hands-on practicum in agriculture.



MAFTOUL

A hand-crafted whole wheat couscous, made in the traditional way by a Palestinian women's co-operative in Jericho.



MEDJOOl DATES

Succulent and sweet, with the flavor of caramel. These dates grown in Jericho are great for snacking, baking, or cooking.



FREEKEH

A toasted green wheat which can be cooked and used to complement a meal with vegetables, fish, or chicken.

sharing information

Old cacao plants don't produce as many pods—but farmer members of CONACADO can renovate their plots by taking clippings of high-producing varieties grown by agronomists at the co-op's nursery, and nurture them with free compost.

FAIR TRADE MEANS

giving back

Our new avocado partner PRAGOR uses fair trade premiums to support environmental initiatives like beekeeping. A group of women care for bee boxes hosted on co-op members' farms, protecting the pollinators their crops depend on.

FAIR TRADE MEANS

farmers get to decide.

Equal Exchange trades only with farmer co-operatives. These men and women do more than work on the land. They vote and serve as leaders—and together, they decide how to use fair trade premiums in their own communities.
