

Ordering for yourself and your community

Individuals/home use:

- Decide what products you'd like to order by browsing our webstore or wholesale case price list.
 There is no minimum but shipping fees may apply. You must order by the full case. A single 5lb bag of whole bean coffee counts as a case. If you would like to share a case with someone you know see the "sharing with friends, family and neighbors" instructions below.
- Order by phone @ 774-776-7366 or at **shop.equalexchange.coop.** When **creating your account**, choose your denomination in the "Coffee Project" drop down menu, if applicable.
- Provide your shipping address & pay by credit card. Receive your order within 10 business days

Congregations:

- Browse products on our webstore or wholesale price list. Shipping fees may apply.
- Order by phone @ 774-776-7366 or at **shop.equalexchange.coop.** When **creating your account** enter your organization & select your denomination in the "Coffee Project" drop-down.
- Provide a shipping address. A home address is fine if the church address is not staffed full-time.
- Pay for the order with a credit card or set up Net 14 billing terms with Equal Exchange.
- Receive order within 10 business days.

To share with family, friends, and neighbors:

- Group members select products and quantities they'd like. There is no minimum but shipping fees may apply. Tally individual orders into case quantities for your group's master order.
- Order by phone @ 774-776-7366 or online **shop.equalexchange.coop.** When **creating your account**, choose your denomination, if applicable, in the "Coffee Project" drop down menu.
- Provide one shipping address to which the group's order will be sent. A home address is fine.
- Pay for the group order using a single credit card. Receive order within 10 business days
- Distribute orders through delivery or a designated pick up point, like the church or your garage.
